CookenPro was evaluated by the Software Evaluation Team, which consists of the Software Evaluation Coordinator and nutritionists at USDA's Food and Nutrition Information Center. Before the USDA can approve a program, all required functions must be incorporated into and working correctly in the program.

Below are some of the benefits of using nutrient analysis software:

- Conduct an accurate nutrient analysis of recipes and menus
- Allow flexibility and variety in menu planning
- Establish age/grade specific RDAs
- Measure compliance with the required nutrient standards for all of the menu options
- Plan menus for a week or longer in cycle format and a calendar
- Weight the nutrient analysis based on production forecasts
- Provide a nutrient source search
- Enter local recipes and processed foods
- Convert nutrient data labels from DRV to nutrients per 100 grams
- Produce a production record
